## The Name of Jesus

Philippians 2:1-11

- Six titles
- Son of God John 20:17
- The word John1:1-4
- High Priest Hebrews 7:23-28
- Messiah John 4: 25
- Son of man Matthew 8:19
- Lord 1 Corinthians 12:1-3

- John 4: 25. The woman said to Him "I know the <u>Messiah</u> is coming (He who is called <u>Christ</u>). When He comes, he will tell us all things." Jesus said to her "I who speak to you am He."
- Messiah = He who is called Christ!
- The prophets say of the <u>Christ</u>:
- He is the promised deliverer
- A leader regarded as the <u>saviour</u>

- What about "Son of God?"
- Imagine not knowing this truth about Jesus!
- How would this affect our witness and the sharing of the Good News?
- We must do all we can to understand Him in all of His true nature and splendour, so that we can effectively share the "Good News."

• Romans 14: 8-9 If we live, we live for the Lord; and if we die, we belong to the Lord. For this very reason, Christ died and returned to life so that he might be the Lord of both the dead and the living.

## Philippians 2:10-11

That at the name of <u>Jesus</u> every knee should bow in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that <u>Jesus Christ</u> is <u>Lord</u>, to the glory of God the father.
