# 1. Faith as a *Choice*

"By faith Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child, and they were not afraid of the king's edict." (Hebrews 11:23)

**"He chose** to be mistreated along  
with the people of God rather than to  
enjoy the fleeting pleasures of  
sin." (Hebrews 11:25)

This was *a serious choice!*

... of greater value than 'the treasures  
of Egypt!'

## 2. Faith as *Perseverance*



"By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he persevered because he saw him who is invisible."

Hebrews 11:27)
