We are always looking for those who like to get involved in new and existing ministries in the church and so if you are keen to serve please speak to me.

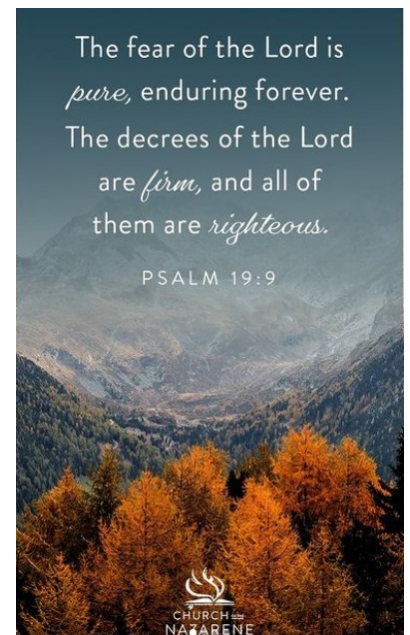

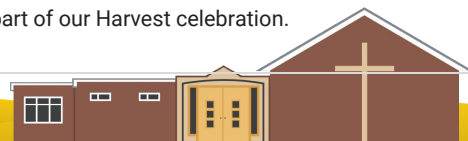

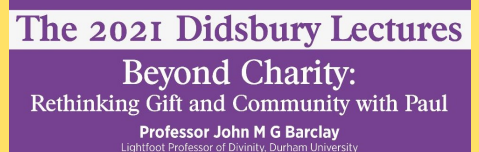
## Sunday 24 October at Brooklands: Chick Yuill

He is a passionate communicator and has appeared on national radio and television in the UK, speaking on issues of faith and morality. He has been a regular speaker at major Christian conferences such as Spring Harvest and ROOTS, and at churches, venues, and conferences throughout the UK as well as in Canada, USA, South Africa, South America, Australia, New Zealand, India, and mainland Europe.

Chick and his wife Margaret have been married for more than 50 years and have two adult daughters, Catriona who is an actor and Jeni who is a lawyer. After his family he has a number of passions – football in general and Manchester United in particular, poetry, jazz, running, good conversation, and good coffee.

Chick and Margaret will be the main speakers at the Thornleigh Christian Hotel in Grange over Sands in the lead up to Easter 2022.
