It is a busy couple of weeks for us as highlighted from our long list of announcements last week:



This coming weekend, we are joining with other Nazarene churches from our district, from the rest of the British Isles, from the rest of Europe, and from parts of Asia, to pray for the church, with emphasis on a couple of situations the Nazarene Church is currently involved with.

Please will you factor this in to your usual prayer routine next Friday and Saturday, or take some extra time out to remember these situations in your prayers.

Next Sunday, there will be an opportunity to give to the works in these areas.

Lebanon: We are all aware of the refugee crisis stimulated by the conflicts in both Iraq and then Syria. Lebanon saw its population doubled from 2 million to 4 million as a result of this, with one in two residents being a refugee! Then came the huge explosion in Beirut in 2020, which, coupled to the impact of Covid has resulted in economic collapse and stimulated tremendous ongoing need. The Church of the Nazarene has a strong and active presence in Lebanon, and so we have an excellent network through which compassionate ministry can take place.

Cyprus: Koinonia Centre: Cyprus is of significant strategic importance because it is one of the only countries on earth where citizens from all the nations of the Middle East, and North Africa, are able to obtain visas and travel to.

Consequently, this centre will enable the training of Pastors and lay leadership, leadership gatherings, retreats, and as an emergency refuge facility for any Christians that need to swiftly exit their country of ministry as a result of persecution and threat to life.

Deeper

Isaiah 54

- 1 "Sing, barren woman, you who never bore a child; burst into song, shout for joy, you who were never in labour; because more are the children of the desolate woman than of her who has a husband," says the Lord.
- 2 "Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes.
- 3 For you will spread out to the right and to the left; your descendants will dispossess nations and settle in their desolate cities.
- 4 "Do not be afraid; you will not be put to shame. Do not fear disgrace; you will not be humiliated. You will forget the shame of your youth and remember no more the reproach of your widowhood. 5 For your Maker is your husband—the Lord Almighty is his name—the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer; he is called the God of all the earth.
- 6 The Lord will call you back as if you were a wife deserted and distressed in spirit—a wife who married young, only to be rejected," says your God.
- 7 "For a brief moment I abandoned you, but with deep compassion I will bring you back. 8 In a surge of anger I hid my face from you for a moment, but with everlasting kindness I will have compassion on you," says the Lord your Redeemer.
- 9 "To me this is like the days of Noah, when I swore that the waters of Noah would never again cover the earth. So now I have sworn not to be angry with you, never to rebuke you again.

 10 Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love for you will not be shaken nor my coverant of peace be removed." says the Lord, who has compassion on

- 11 "Afflicted city, lashed by storms and not comforted, I will rebuild you with stones of turquoise, your foundations with lapis lazuli.
- 12 I will make your battlements of rubies, your gates of sparkling jewels, and all your walls of precious stones.
- 13 All your children will be taught by the Lord, and great will be their peace.
- 14 In righteousness you will be established: Tyranny will be far from you; you will have nothing to fear. Terror will be far removed; it will not come near you.
- 15 If anyone does attack you, it will not be my doing; whoever attacks you will surrender to you.
- 16 "See, it is I who created the blacksmith who fans the coals into flame and forges a weapon fit for its work. And it is I who have created the destroyer to wreak havoc;
- 17 no weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and this is their vindication from me," declares the Lord.
