I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Saviour, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. (1 Tim 2:1-4).

This week we continue to mourn the loss of Queen Elizabeth II. She was just twenty-five years old when she ascended to the throne following the death of her beloved father King George VI. In her grief she took on the incredible responsibility and scrutiny of being sovereign. She served her people faithfully for over seventy years, still working hard in her last few days. Queen Elizabeth spoke of her strong Christian faith that sustained her throughout her life. Ahead of her coronation she asked people to pray for her "that God may give me wisdom and strength to carry out the solemn promises I shall be making, and that I may faithfully serve Him and you, all the days of my life." God certainly answered this prayer. Now we pray for King Charles during this period of immense grief that he will serve God and his people with faith and wisdom.
