From the Pastor

"For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea. They were all baptised into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. They all ate the same spiritual food and drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ." - 1 Corinthians 10:1-4

As we continue our journey through the Old Testament narrative during Lent we come to Moses who led the Israelites through the desert. Whilst there God used Moses to quench their thirst by bringing forth water from a stone. Above, the apostle Paul tells us that stone was Christ! This is key for our understanding of these stories. God, in Christ has been at work to save us from the very beginning. Tim did a tremendous job last week of showing us how Abraham served as a type of Christ – standing between God and humanity and allowing blessing to flow through him.

Next week we will take a short break from our preaching series as it is Mothering Sunday. As well as taking an opportunity to bless all of the mothers in our congregation, my own mother, Adele Duncan, will be our guest preacher. I've no doubt you'll make her feel welcome as she shares some of her testimony and brings teaching from God's Word.

A special note for the following, Sunday, 26th March. We will be joined that morning by the folks from King's Church Wythenshawe whose usual place of worship is not available. This will be a wonderful testimony of Kingdom work where two churches join together in unity and worship. Note that church is likely to be extra busy that morning so you may want to arrive a little early to guarantee seats together.

Don't forget that this Saturday is our prayer breakfast followed by a special time of fellowship and teaching. Jon Fisher is pulling this together so please speak to him for more details.

EVERY STORY WHISPERS HIS NAME (3) - MICK KANE

EXODUS 17:1-7

1 The whole Israelite community set out from the Desert of Sin, traveling from place to place as the Lord commanded. They camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink. 2 So they quarreled with Moses and said, "Give us water to drink."

Moses replied, "Why do you quarrel with me? Why do you put the Lord to the test?"

- 3 But the people were thirsty for water there, and they grumbled against Moses. They said, "Why did you bring us up out of Egypt to make us and our children and livestock die of thirst?"
- 4 Then Moses cried out to the Lord, "What am I to do with these people? They are almost ready to stone me."

5 The Lord answered Moses, "Go out in front of the people. Take with you some of the elders of Israel and take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go. 6 I will stand there before you by the rock at Horeb. Strike the rock, and water will come out of it for the people to drink." So Moses did this in the sight of the elders of Israel. 7 And he called the place Massah because the Israelites quarreled and because they tested the Lord saying, "Is the Lord among us or not?"
