Palm Sunday

## "I tell you," he replied, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out." Luke 19:40

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday, Jesus triumphant entry into Jerusalem, with many churches the world over. Our journey through Lent has led us to this place. As we have considered the overarching story of the Old Testament we have come to this conclusion: It all points to Jesus!

That means it's time to get ready. In the Scriptures, Jesus begins his final journey towards the cross and as he is welcomed into the city we join with those present who were laying down their cloaks (a sign of royalty) and waving palm branches (a sign of victory) in welcoming Jesus with worship. To help us with this we are pleased to have Manchester Community Gospel Choir who will begin our time performing some songs of worship for us.

A reminder that Friday this week is Good Friday, the day we focus on Christ's work on the cross. We will gather in the church at 10am for a reflective service and in the evening again in Wythenshawe Park (Rose Garden) at 6pm with other churches to witness and worship.

Then on Sunday we celebrate Easter - Resurrection Sunday - and this year we will have an all age family service in which will see new memberships, a baptism, communion and a time of worship and reflection which will include the children. We'll meet at our usual time of 10.30am.
