"I hate, I despise... says the Lord."

Amos 5:21-27

Dear friends

I don't know about you, but I find it very jarring to read the words 'I hate' coming from God's mouth. So often our focus is on God as a being of love; God is love! So how can it make sense that that hatred might flow from God's heart? But there it is, right there in the Scripture. We really are dealing with the emotional heart of God in this series, aren't we?

And in fact, it is because God loves so ferociously, that he does have hatred for anything that brings harm to those he does love. That's what we're dealing with here! God loves his people so much, that when systems, and actions result in harm to them, particularly the vulnerable of them, he is riled up in his heart.

SUNDAY 24 SEPTEMBER 2023 AMOS 5: 4-7: 21-24 - PASTOR MICK

4 This is what the Lord says to Israel: "Seek me and live; 5 do not seek Bethel, do not go to Gilgal, do not journey to Beersheba. For Gilgal will surely go into exile, and Bethel will be reduced to nothing." 6 Seek the Lord and live, or he will sweep through the tribes of Joseph like a fire; it will devour them, and Bethel will have no one to quench it. 7 There are those who turn justice into bitterness and cast righteousness to the ground.

21 "I hate, I despise your religious festivals; your assemblies are a stench to me. 22 Even though you bring me burnt offerings and grain offerings, I will not accept them. Though you bring choice fellowship offerings, I will have no regard for them. 23 Away with the noise of your songs! I will not listen to the music of your harps. 24 But let justice roll on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream!

25 "Did you bring me sacrifices and offerings forty years in the wilderness, people of Israel? 26 You have lifted up the shrine of your king, the pedestal of your idols, the star of your god—which you made for yourselves. 27 Therefore I will send you into exile beyond Damascus," says the Lord, whose name is God Almighty.
